Adult Inpatient Program

The Adult Inpatient Program at Archbold Northside is a short-term program that provides treatment for men and women ages 18 to 54, who are experiencing psychiatric and chemical dependency problems.

Our 22-bed secured unit is designed for adults who are in crisis and need 24-hour observation in a safe, structured environment.

Psychiatric Services

We provide treatment for a range of psychiatric problems, including depression, anxiety, bipolar disorder, schizophrenia, post-traumatic stress disorder, and other mental health conditions.

Chemical Dependency and Dual Diagnosis Services

Northside utilizes *Living in Balance*, an evidence-based treatment program, for treating patients who are dealing with alcohol, drug or opiate addiction.

Our comprehensive treatment program includes:

- Psychiatric evaluation
- Psychosocial assessment
- History and Physical Exam
- Medical management
- 24-hour skilled nursing care
- Medically supervised drug and alcohol detoxification
- Medication evaluation and management
- Individualized treatment plan
- Individual and group therapy
- Recreational and educational therapy
- Case management
- Patient and family education

Admissions and Referrals

Admission is possible 24 hours a day by referral or by calling the HELPLINE. Referrals can be made without medical clearance by many professionals and organizations in the community such as: physicians, hospitals, mental health providers, law enforcement, family members and patients themselves.

Treatment at Northside is covered in whole or in part by most health insurance plans.

Assessment and Evaluation

If you or someone you know needs help, call our 24-hour HELPLINE at 800.238.8661 to speak with a qualified and caring professional who can answer your questions and help you plan your next step.

Our team will conduct an initial assessment free of charge needed to determine the most appropriate level of care.

We accept private insurance, private pay, Medicare and Georgia Medicaid.

Discharge and Aftercare Planning

Upon completion of the Adult Inpatient Program, a referral may be made for less intensive treatment such as partial hospitalization, outpatient or intensive outpatient treatment, or through an aftercare program.
